

CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN

Hebrews 3:7-13

PASTOR: Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says,
 “Today, if you hear his voice,
 do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion,
 on the day of testing in the wilderness,
 where your fathers put me to the test
 and saw my works for forty years.
 Therefore I was provoked with that generation,
 and said, ‘They always go astray in their heart;
 they have not known my ways.’
 As I swore in my wrath,
 ‘They shall not enter my rest.’”
 Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil,
 unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living
 God. But exhort one another every day, as long as it is
 called “today,” that none of you may be hardened by the
 deceitfulness of sin.

CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

**ALL: Merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against
 you in thought, word, and deed, both by what we
 have done, and by what we have left undone. We
 have not loved you with our whole heart and mind
 and strength. We have ignored your command to love
 our neighbors as ourselves. We have not sought to
 show love to our enemies. In your mercy forgive the
 sin that so easily entangles us. Cleanse us from our
 impulses to defy your holiness. Transform us that
 our hearts may delight in your will. Teach us to walk
 in your ways and to run with perseverance the race
 set before us, that we may bring glory to your holy
 name, through Christ Jesus, our Lord. Amen.**

 take hold of the forgiveness won for us by Christ, our Redeemer.*

 through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast
 our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is

 every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.
 Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of
 grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in
 time of need.

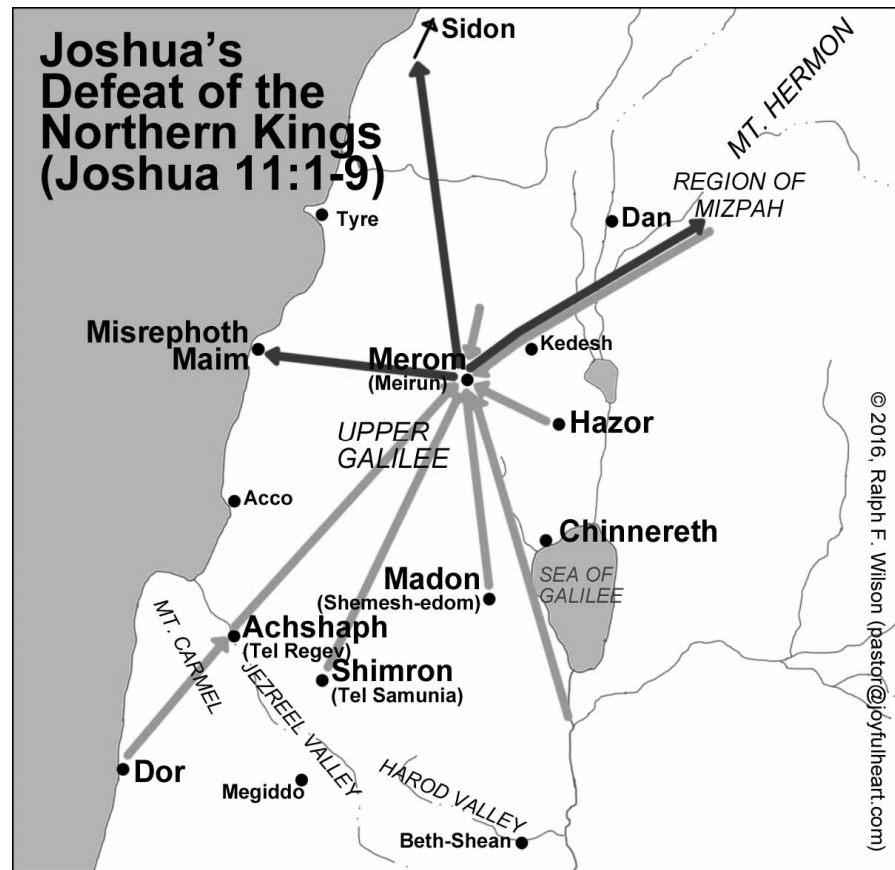

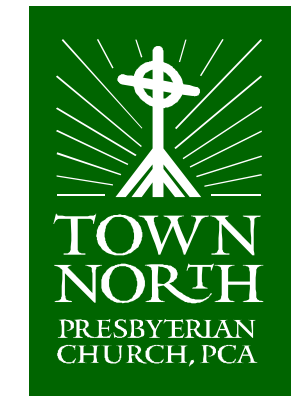
