

REFLECTION

"In this way does one, whom God has placed in common life with other Christians, learn what it means to have brothers. Brothers in the Lord,' as Paul calls his congregation (Philippians 1:14). One is a brother to another only through Jesus Christ. I am a brother to another person through what Jesus Christ did for me and to me; the other person has become a brother to me through what Jesus Christ did for him. This fact that we are brothers only through Jesus Christ is of immeasurable significance. Not only the other person who is earnest and devout, who comes to me seeking brotherhood, must I deal with in fellowship. My brother is rather that other person who has been redeemed by Christ...What determines our brotherhood is what that man is by reason of Christ."
