

"Isaiah 45:22: 'Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth.'"

"This is a very simple text indeed. It says, 'Look.' Now lookin' don't take a deal of pain. It ain't liftin' your foot or your finger; it is just 'Look.' Well, a man needn't go to college to learn to look. You may be the biggest fool, and yet you can look. A man needn't be worth a thousand pounds a year to look. Anyone can look; even a child can look.

But then the text says, 'Look unto Me.' Ay! many of you are lookin' to yourselves, but it's no use lookin' there. You'll never find any comfort in yourselves."
