

CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN

Mark 7:20-23

LEADER: And [Jesus] said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."

SILENT CONFESSION OF SIN

In these moments, we individually come to God in prayer, silently confessing personal sins so that we may take hold of the forgiveness won for us by Christ, our Redeemer.

CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

ALL: Most just and merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against the mercy you have given us through the death and resurrection of your Son, Jesus. Though we are forgiven, we have not sought first your kingdom. We have often run into temptation. We have often nurtured the sin we should have put to death. Have mercy on us. 
ASSURANCE OF FORGIVENESS

Westminster Confession of Faith Chapter 13: Sanctification, Section 1 (Modern English Version)

L: Those who are effectually called and regenerated

ALL: Those who are effectually called and regenerated have a new heart and a new spirit created in them. They are additionally sanctified,

actually and personally,

by the power of Christ's death and resurrection

and by his word and Spirit dwelling in them.

The power of sin ruling over the whole body is destroyed,

and the desires of the old self

are more and more weakened and killed.

At the same time the ability to practice true holiness,

without which no one will see the Lord,

is brought to life and strengthened by all the saving graces.
