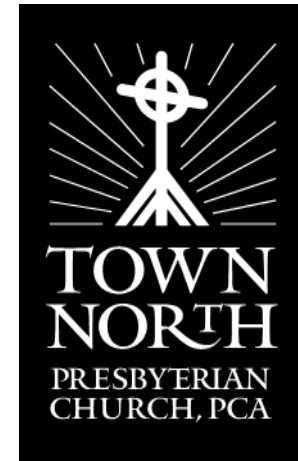

CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN

***Colossians 3:12-14***
