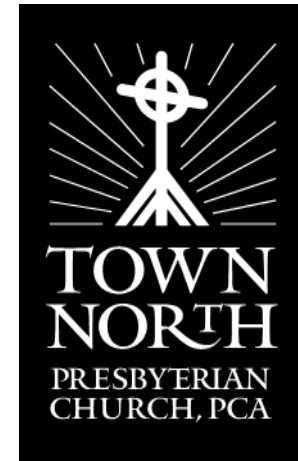



CALL TO CONFESSION OF SIN

Romans 12:1-2

LEADER: I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

ALL: **Our Father, you have called us to be holy as you are holy—to live distinct and sacrificial lives, having been sanctified and set apart for your purposes. Yet we confess that we are reluctant to deny ourselves, take up our cross and follow Christ. Our love for you is often quenched by our love of self and for the things of this world; our concern to do your will often overridden by a desire to do what we want. Have mercy on us and forgive these our sins. Transform us by the renewal of our minds, so that by testing we might do what is good, acceptable and perfect. In Jesus' name, Amen.**

SILENT CONFESSION OF SIN

In these moments, we individually come to God in prayer, silently confessing personal sins so that we may take hold of the forgiveness won for us by Christ, our Redeemer.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

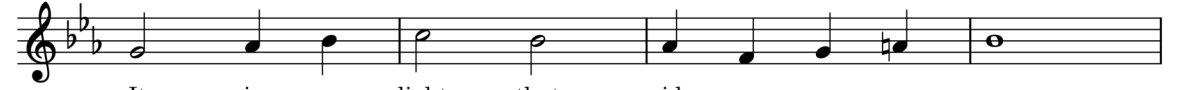

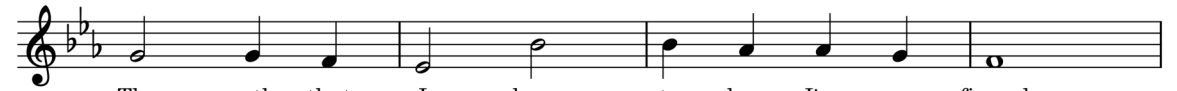
Your Word's a Lamp that Shines Before My Feet (Psalm 119)
